Tournament format
Qualification: Entrys + Re-entries: All Categories (1 Mixed, 2 Male, 2 Female, 3 Mixed) will play 6 games (American style)
Order of qualification: An athlete may qualify for the Finals only once. If an athlete has played multiple squads, only their highest squad will be used for advancement.
Final step 1 Pins incl. HCP is carried forward from qualification to step 1 Category 1-Mixed: Top 8 athletes qualify for step 1

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Category 2-M: Top 12 male qualify for step 1
Category 2-F: Top 12 female qualify for step 1
Category 3-Mixed: Top 8 athletes qualify for step 1

Athletes play 5 games.

Final step 2

Category 1-Mixed: Top 4 athletes from step 1 qualify for step 2
Category 2-M: Top 4 male athletes qualify from step 1 qualify for step 2
Category 2-F: Top 4 female athletes from step 1 qualify for step 2
Category 3-Mixed: Top 6 athletes from step 1 qualify for step 2

Final step 2 - Knockout Rounds

Pins from Qualification and Final Step 1 will not be carried forward.
Each category will compete on one assigned lane pair and bowl three games.

After each game, the athlete with the lowest cumulative pinfall in that category will be eliminated.

The first athlete eliminated will be ranked 4th, the second athlete eliminated will be ranked 3rd, and the third athlete eliminated will be ranked 2nd.

The remaining athlete with the highest total pinfall after all three games will be declared the winner and Champion of Hammer Youth Tour – Stop 2 Brörup.

Tournament tie rules

Qualification and Final Step 1 and 2

Incase of a tie in Qualification

In case of a tie in total pinfall after the six qualification games, the athlete with the highest score in the last qualification game will be ranked highest.

If a tie still exists, the athlete with the highest score in the second-last game will be ranked highest, then the third-last game, and so on until the tie is broken.

If a tie still exists after comparing all six qualification games, a one-ball roll-off will be played. Additional one-ball roll-offs will be played as necessary until the tie is broken. The winner of the roll-off will be ranked highest.

In case of a tie in Final step 1

In case of a tie in total pinfall in Final Step 1, the athlete with the highest score in the last game of Final Step 1 will be ranked highest.

If a tie still exists, the athlete with the highest score in the second-last game will be ranked highest, then the third-last game, and so on until the tie is broken.

If a tie still exists after comparing all games in Final Step 1, a one-ball roll-off will be played. Additional one-ball roll-offs will be played as necessary until the tie is broken. The winner of the roll-off will be ranked highest.

In case of tie in final step 2 - Knockout Rounds

In case of a tie in total pinfall after any game in Final Step 2, a one-ball roll-off will be played. Additional one-ball roll-offs will be played as necessary until the tie is broken.

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The winner of the roll-off will advance to the next game or, if the tie occurs after the final game, will be declared the winner of Hammer Youth Tour - Stop 2 Brörup.

One-Ball Roll-Off Procedure

For all one-ball roll-offs, the higher-seeded athlete from the previous stage will have the choice of either:

- Selecting which athlete bowls first; or
- Selecting the lane on which they will bowl within the assigned lane pair.

For roll-offs in Final Step 1, seeding will be based on the Qualification standings.

For roll-offs in Final Step 2, seeding will be based on the Final Step 1 standings.

In a one-ball roll-off, each athlete will bowl one delivery. The athlete knocking down the greater number of pins will be declared the winner.

If the athletes knock down an equal number of pins, additional one-ball roll-offs will be played until the tie is broken.

Lane assignments and lane movements

Lane draws	Carried through by organizer
Athletes per pair in squads	Max. 4
Frequency of movement	After every game (in qualifying games)
Movement method	Athletes starting on the left lane of a lane pair will move one lane pair to the left after each game. Athletes starting on the right lane of a lane pair will move one lane pair to the right after each game. During the Final Steps, each category will remain within its own designated lane section and will not compete on lane pairs used by other categories. In Final Step 2 – Knockout Rounds, each category will be assigned one lane pair, which will be used for all three games.
Number of lanes to move	2 lanes

Booking policies

Booking restriction before	A maximum of three squads may be booked before the start of the tournament. For the final weekend of qualification (Friday and Saturday), a maximum of two squads may be booked.
Booking restriction during	Once the tournament has started, there is no limit to the number of squads that may be booked.
Total number of bookings	There is no limit to the total number of bookings.
Booking cancellations	Cancellations should be made no later than 24 hours before the scheduled squad start time.
Registration deadline	Registration closes 30 minutes before the scheduled squad start time.

About Hammer Youth Tour

Hammer Youth Tour is an international youth bowling tour consisting of four qualifying stops across Denmark and Sweden (Eslöv, Brørup, Køge and Nässjö), followed by a Masters Final.

The tour is designed to provide young athletes with high-level competition, valuable tournament experience, and the opportunity to compete against the strongest youth bowlers from across the Nordic region and all across Europe.

Each stop awards ranking points towards the overall Hammer Youth Tour standings. The highest-ranked athletes after the qualifying stops will earn a place in the Masters Final, where the overall Hammer Youth Tour champions will be crowned.

Hammer Youth Tour – Stop 2 Brørup is the second stop of the 2026 season.

Location and Transportation

Brørup is conveniently located in the heart of Denmark and is easily accessible for both Danish and international participants.

The tournament venue is situated approximately 30 minutes (by car) from Billund Airport and around 50 minutes (by car) from the German border, making travel simple for participants from across Scandinavia and all of Europe.
